




5. Creating a File Creating a drawing

To create a simple drawing that can be saved as a graphic file, follow the procedure on the next page.


Click the line tool button on the Paint toolbar.



Point the line tool pointer to a place near the top of the drawing area so that there an equal amount of space on either side.




Click and drag the mouse down to draw a vertical line. Release the button to end the line.



Step 4

Repeat the process to draw a horizontal line.
