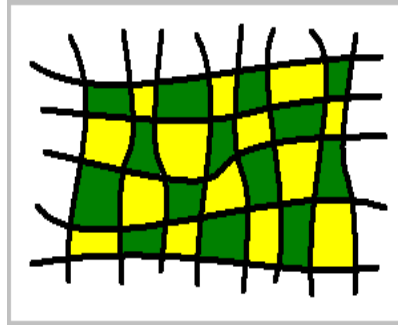


## 8. Curve Tool Project - Silly Chessboard

This project uses the Curve tool to make a silly chessboard.



## Step One

Open Paint, and click the Curve tool icon to select the Curve tool. Then select one of the larger Curve tool size choices.

Click to select one of the larger Curve tool size choices.



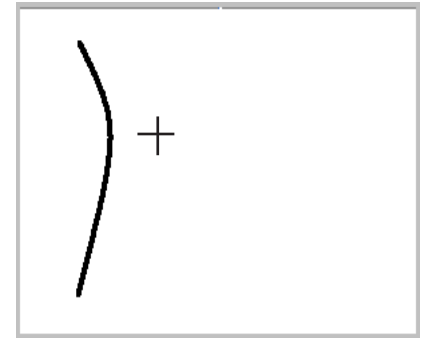
## Step Two

Point to a place in the top, left-hand corner of the canvas, and click-and-drag down to the bottom of the canvas, then release the left button.



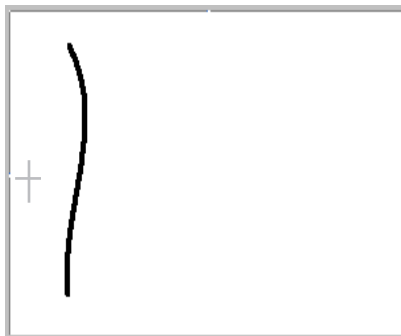
## Step Three

Click to the right of the line to bend it to the right.



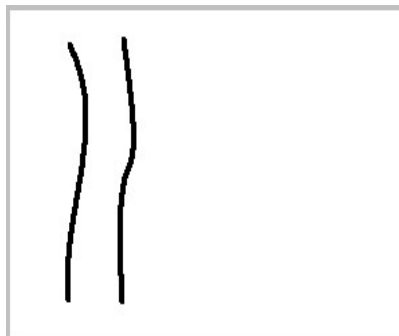
#### Step Four

Click to the left of the line to bend it in the opposite direction



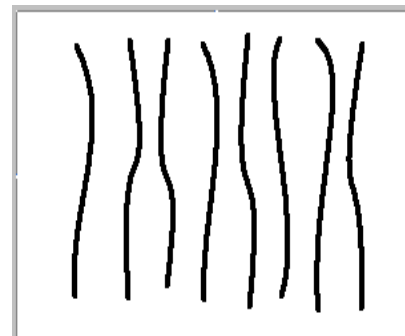
#### Step Five

Add another line to the right of your first line, and bend it using the same process.



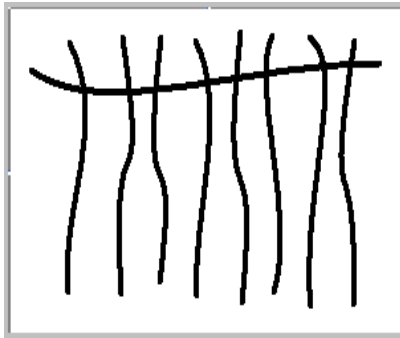
#### Step Six

Continue to add and bend lines until you run out of space.



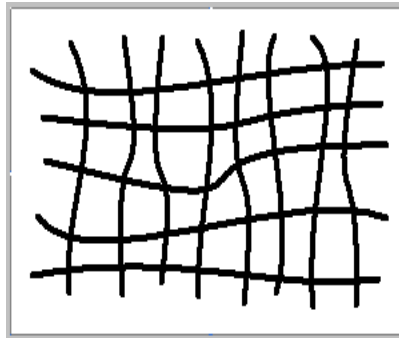
### Step Seven

Starting in the upper left-hand corner of the canvas, draw a horizontal line that crosses over all of the vertical lines that you have drawn. Bend the line after you have drawn it.



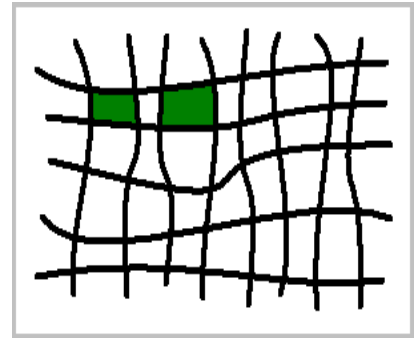
### Step Eight

Continue to add and bend lines until you run out of space.



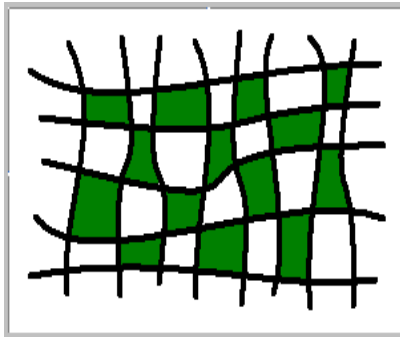
### Step Nine

Select the Fill-With\_Color tool, then select a color from the color box. Fill in every other space inside your silly chess board.



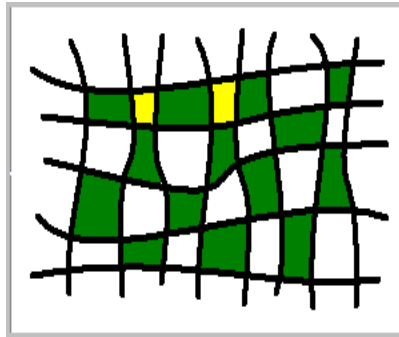
### Step Ten

Continue filling in every other space until you have finished.



### Step Eleven

Choose a new color from the color box, and fill in the the uncolored spaces.



### Step Twelve

Continue the process until you have completely filled your silly chess board.
