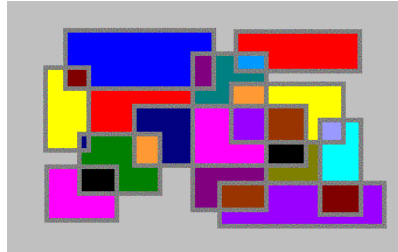


#### 4. Rectangle Tool Project - Boxes

This project uses the Rectangle tool to make an image with rectangles that are drawn on top of each other and filled with different colors using the Fill With Color tool.



## Step One

Open Paint, and click the Rectangle tool icon to select the Rectangle tool. Then, select the first rectangle choice. Finally, select a color for the outline of your boxes by clicking a choice in the color box.

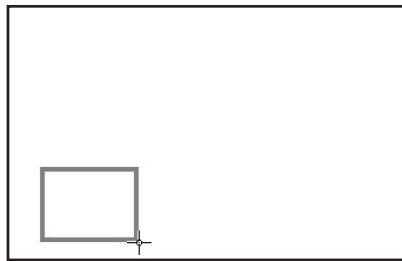
Paint toolbox with Rectangle tool selected.

Click to select the first rectangle choice.



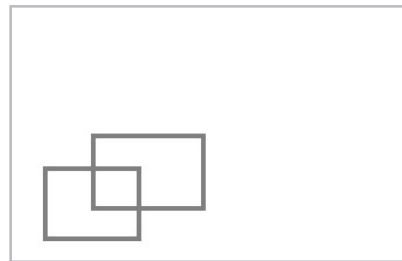
## Step Two

Point to a place inside the canvas, then click-and-drag to make a rectangle. Release the left button to finish.



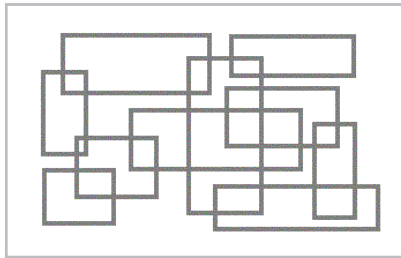
## Step Three

Point to a place near the first rectangle, then click-and-drag to make another rectangle over part of the first one. Release the left button to finish.



#### Step Four

Continue to add additional rectangles.



#### Step Five

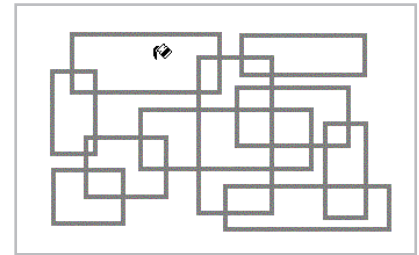
After you have drawn all of your rectangles, select the Fill With Color tool from the toolbar

Paint toolbox with Fill With Color tool selected.



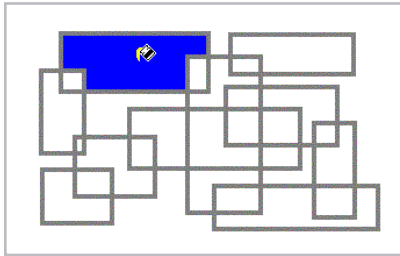
#### Step Six

Use the Fill With Color tool to select a color from the color box, then point to one of the empty spaces inside the rectangles you have drawn.



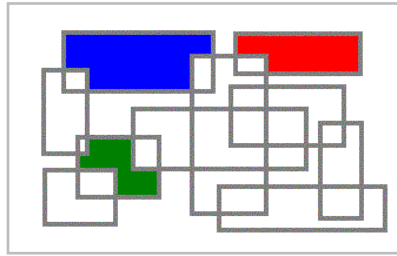
### Step Seven

Click to fill the selected space.



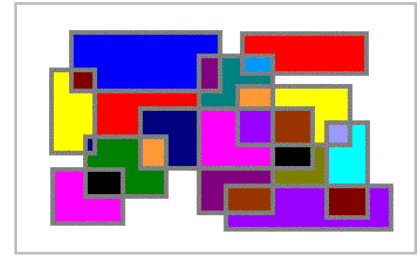
### Step Eight

Use the Fill With Color tool to fill the other spaces in your drawing with different colors.



### Step Nine

Continue until you fill all of the empty spaces in your drawing.



## Step Ten

If you wish, you can use the Fill With Color tool to fill the remaining empty space with a background color.
