<p>Save a copy of the Excel Vacation Budget Planner worksheet in your folder, then use it to find out how much it would cost for everyone in your family to spend three days and two nights at Disneyland in Anaheim, CA according to the following specifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use the Disneyland Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost to transport all the members of your family from your house to the park and back again. If you are using Option 1, put that amount in the Transportation Amount cell for Day 1 and Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. If you are using Option 2, put the plane ticket amount in the Transportation Amount cell for Day 1 and the rental car fee for three days in the Transportation Amount cell for Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Disneyland Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for admission for all of the members of your family to the park. Put that amount in the Admission Fees Amount cell for Day 1 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Disneyland Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for breakfast, lunch, and dinner as well as a snack for each member of your family for three days. Put that amount in the Food Amount cell for Day 1, Day 2, and Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Disneyland Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for each member of your family to get some stuff to bring home from the park. Put that amount in the Stuff Amount cell for Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Disneyland Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for lodging your family for two nights. Put that amount in the Lodging Amount cell for Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • When you have completed your Vacation Budget Planner worksheet, use the Edit > Save As command to save it in your folder. <p>Use the Excel Vacation Budget Planner worksheet to make two spending plans for everyone in your family to spend three days and two nights at the Santa Cruz Boardwalk in Santa Cruz, CA according to the following specifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The first spending plan is for \$100.00 per person, and the second is for \$170 dollars per person. Multiply the amount per person by the number of people in your family and put the result in the Vacation Money cell in the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost to transport all the members of your family from your house to the Boardwalk. Put that amount in the Transportation Amount cell for Day 1 and Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Go to the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Web site to find out how much it costs to go on the rides and do stuff. Then use the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for all of the members of your family to go on the rides for one day. You will need to put in the amount for admission on the rides in the appropriate How Much? cell. Put the total amount in the Admission Fees Amount cell for Day 1, Day 2, and Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Use the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Menu worksheet to find out how much it would cost for breakfast, lunch, and dinner as well as a snack for each member of your family for three days. Put the total amount in the Lodging Amount cell for Day 3 on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • Your Vacation Budget Worksheet is completed when you have no more than \$5.00 left of your Vacation Money. If you find that you have spent more than your Vacation Money amount on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet, go back to the Santa Cruz Boardwalk Menu and look for places where you can reduce or eliminate your spending and put the new amounts in the appropriate cells on the Vacation Budget Planner worksheet. • When you have completed your spending plan for \$100.00 per person, use the Edit > Save As command to save your worksheet in your folder. Name this file "VBP2SR_<your name>." • When you have finished your \$100.00 per person spending plan, follow the same steps to make a \$170.00 per person spending plan. Use the Edit > Save As command to save this worksheet in your folder. Name this file "VBP2ISR2_<your name>." 	
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
